MINUTES

October 3, 2011

Board met in regular session with Lynn Zeller, Donald Schwalm and Harold Smith in attendance. Minutes of previous meeting as amended and treasurer report were approved. In attendance were David Smith from Light-Heigel, residents Larry Hoke and Tom Shuttlesworth and Attorney Joseph Kerwin.

Dave Smith presented a new fee schedule for Year 2012 for sewage enforcement services. Increase was 5% over last year and he noted that fees have not increased in last five years.

Halloween Activities – Trick/Treat night – Thursday Oct 27, 2011, 6-8PM; Parade – Sunday Oct 30, 2011, 5PM, Rain Date Oct 31, 2011. Board approved donation of \$100.00 to parade committee.

Discussion of Flood 2011 damage and repairs. Resolution 04-2011 appointing Harold L. Smith as designated agent for PEMA/FEMA actions relating to the flood. Meetings with PEMA and FEMA scheduled to identify damage and possible reimbursement. Board also agreed to apply under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for storm drainage improvement.

Treasurer was instructed to prepare a draft budget for Year 2012 to be presented at next meeting.

Supervisor Schwalm submitted his resignation from the Board effective October 4, 2011 citing personal reasons. Motion by Smith, Second by Zeller to accept resignation. Secretary was instructed to advertise the opening on the Board.
